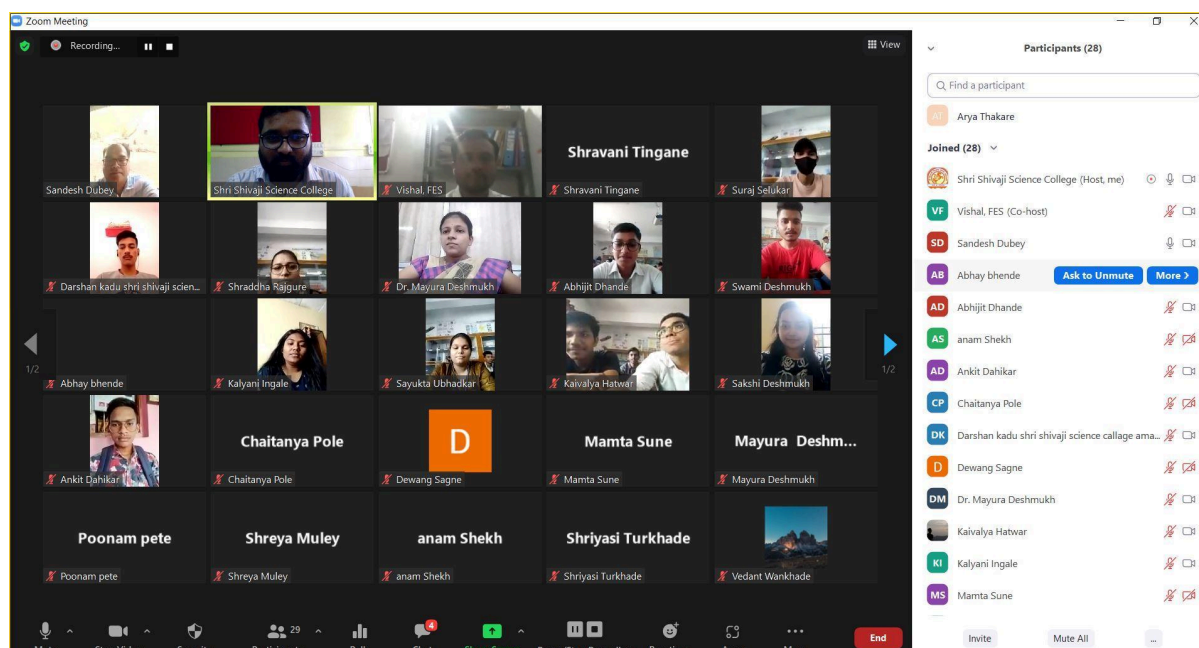


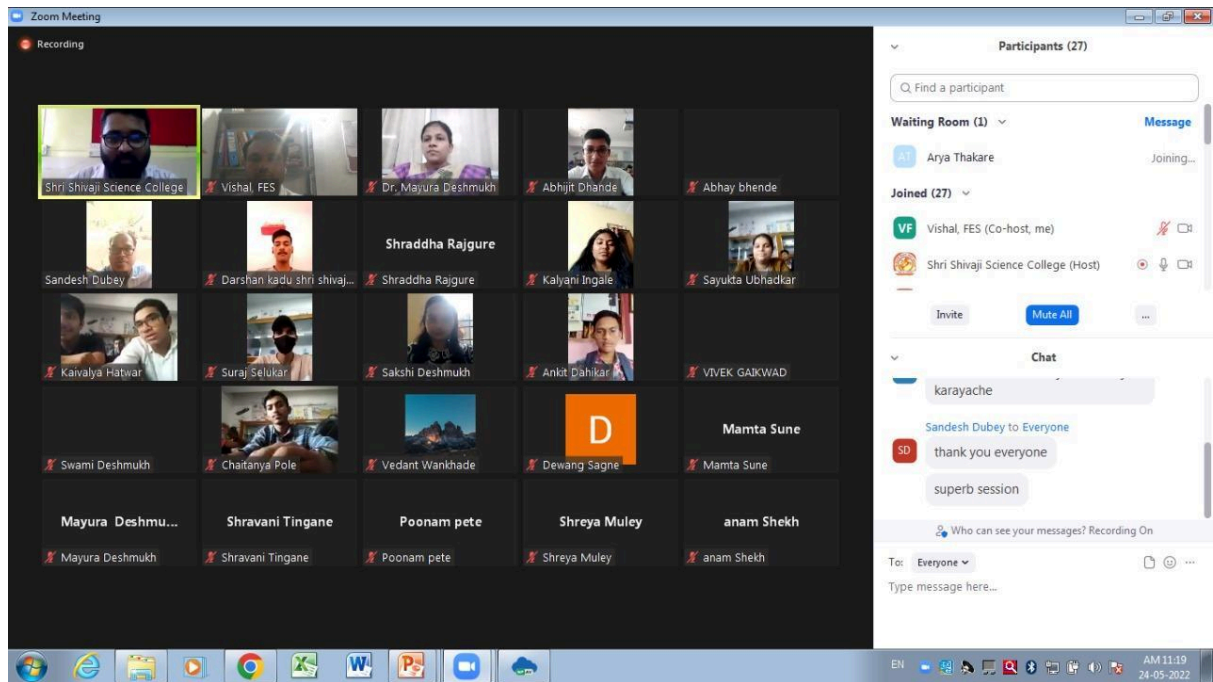

**Workshop On Napo Jal Bachao Kal with FES**

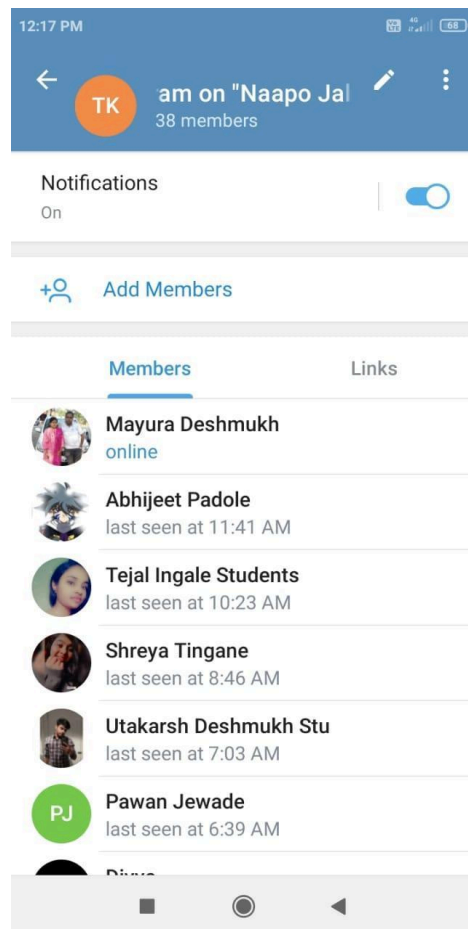
Shri Shivaji Science College, Department of Geology in collaboration with Foundation for Ecological Security (FES), Gujarat, India organized 1-day workshop on "Napo Jal Bachao Kal". Foundation for Ecological Security (FES), Anand, Gujarat is a not-for-profit organization founded in 2001 working towards conservation of nature and natural resources through collective action of local communities. "Napo Jal Bachao Kal" is **participatory national campaign to map and measure wells across villages of India and enhance the collective understanding of groundwater as a shared, common resource.** The campaign previously has been carried out twice every year - once in the pre-monsoon period and again in the post-monsoon period.

For above said activity Mr. Vishal Chavhan, Senior Project Manager FES and Mr. Sandesh Dubey, Program Manager gave virtual training for ground water level data collection to students on behalf of FES. Mr. Vishal Chavhan is working with FES from last 7 years and he specializes in water governance and he provides training on tools and technology to different stakeholders of society.
