Types of Questions

Literal (L) = the answer is in the text.

Reorganisation (R) = the answer is in different places in the text

Inference (I) = the answer is suggested and we have to find the clues

Vocabulary (V) = the answer is about the meaning of words

Evaluation (E) = the answer needs us to bring different ideas together

1]. What does an unripe Strawberry look like? (I)

A]. *Small, hard, white with green dots*

2] What season do strawberries grow? (I)

A]. *Summer.*

3]. How did Mum want to eat the strawberries? (L)

A]. *With ice cream*

4]. Who did Huia think ate the first missing berry? (I)

A]. *Her brother Tama*

5]. What is a kiore? (V)

A]. *A Rat*

6]. Whis a Rāhui? (V)

A]. *A law/rule*

7]. Why did Huia want to put a Rāhui on the strawberries? (I)

A]. *To stop them from being eaten*

8]. Who agreed to the Rāhui? (I)

A]. *Mum, Dad, Tama. She thought the sparrow and kiore understood too.*

9]. Did the Rāhui work? (I)

A]. *Yes there were 26 strawberries for Mums birthday*

10]. Who do you think was eating the strawberries? Why? (E)

A]. *Tama - he could understand the Rāhui but the sparrow and kiore couldn't*
