Who are New Americans?

New Americans in Colorado include immigrants and their children who have come to the U.S. for safety, opportunity, or family reunification. They make up **9.8% of the Colorado population**. This group encompasses refugees, asylees, DACA recipients, Special Immigrant Visa holders, and others. New Americans contribute to all sectors of society, including education, healthcare, business, and community life. Within this diverse group, each individual's background and experiences shape their identity, just as with U.S.-born citizens. Their experiences enrich the broader community, reflecting a variety of cultures, skills, and perspectives. New Americans bring significant value to businesses, especially in sectors facing labor shortages and skill gaps.

- New Americans have **education, skills, and work experience** that are often transferable to careers in America.
- Many New Americans are **motivated, resilient, and flexible workers** eager to provide for their families, and they can offer valuable foreign language skills.
- Employers report that New Americans often stay longer in jobs compared to typical U.S. employees, **reducing costly turnover**.

A diverse team brings varied perspectives, which can help generate new ideas and strengthen a company's reputation. Companies that hire New Americans demonstrate social responsibility, which can attract loyal customers and employees who value businesses that contribute to positive community impact.
