### **Assignment 1: Create an Anti-Discrimination Vocabulary Poster**

#### **Task Description:**

Create a visual poster that promotes positive language and actions against discrimination based on ethnicity. Your poster should help classmates understand how words can support respect, equality, and cultural diversity.

#### **Instructions:**

1. Choose 10–20 English words or short phrases that encourage inclusion and respect.
2. Design a poster where these words are clearly presented and visually engaging.
3. You may organize the words in categories (e.g., *values, actions, rights, feelings*) or arrange them in a creative visual layout.
4. Add at least 3 visual elements (illustrations, icons, symbols, colors) that support the message.
5. Include a short slogan (1–2 sentences) that expresses why fighting ethnic discrimination is important.
6. Your poster should be suitable for display at school during Erasmus+ week.

To demonstrate how language can influence attitudes and contribute to an inclusive school environment.
