Board members appoint Ron Recinto to fill open position on the Board of Education

Farmington, MI -- On Thursday, June 12, the Board of Education held candidate interviews after receiving the applications from the candidates. The interviews can be viewed on the District's YouTube Channel: https://www.youtube.com/fpstv10.

Originally, 16 individuals applied for the vacancy. Two did not meet the eligibility requirements, one applicant withdrew their application, and two were unable to attend the interviews.

After discussion and deliberation at their June 17 Board of Education meeting, Ron Recinto was selected to fill out the remainder of David Turner's term, which will end in December 2026.

Ron has resided in the District for the past 19 years, and he and his wife have two children in the District. He earned his Master of Science degree in Reporting on Science and Medicine from Boston University and his Bachelor of Arts degree from Wabash College.

"The Board was thrilled to receive so many qualified applicants, each bringing a unique perspective and set of strengths that reflected a strong commitment to public education," stated Board of Education President Terri Weems. "After careful consideration, the Board appointed Ron Recinto to fill the vacancy because of his background in communications, leadership, and community engagement. He will be an asset to the District, and we look forward to his contributions in the months ahead."
