Sentence:	
He likes soccer. He does not like basketball.	<i>He likes soccer, but he does not like basketball.</i>
I washed my hands. I ate lunch.	<i>I washed my hands, and I ate lunch.</i>
Do you want an apple? Do you want a pear?	<i>Do you want an apple, or do you want a pear?</i>
I like pizza. I do not like mushrooms.	
The dog barked. The cat ran away.	
Is it a cat? Is it a dog?	
She wants to read. She is very tired.	
We played outside. We had a lot of fun.
