

MacOS: Mirroring to Vizio Classroom Display

This guide will share how to display what is on your computer screen (iMac or Macbook) on your classroom TV.

Be sure to follow the directions for the correct type of display, Vizio or Newline. See below.

Have a Newline Touch Screen TV instead?

These are new touch screen TVs in our district. You will see a Newline logo on the screen and embossed on the TV frame. [Please follow these steps](#).

Vizio Displays/TVs

1. Find the remote control. Press the Power button on the remote.



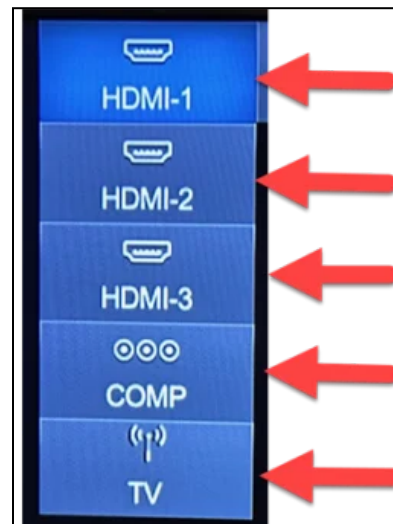
2. If you see a display that refers to either Airplay or AppleTV, then you are ready to connect your Macbook or iMac, and you can skip the next step.



3. Use the *Input* button on the remote to select the correct input for Apple TV.

You may have to select a new input on the TV until you find the one that the Apple TV is connected to. To do this, press the Input button. You will see a list of inputs for the TV. They may just have generic port names (like below) or they may be labelled (e.g. Apple TV).

Press the Input button to select a different input. Wait 5 seconds to see if the display shows the Apple TV device. If it does not, press the Input button again to display the inputs, and press it one more time to move to the next input.



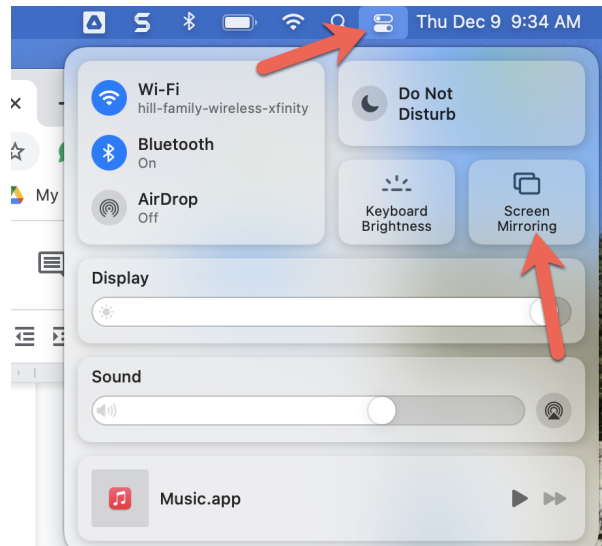
4. **Log into your sub Macbook**
Please use your Google (Gmail) complete address (e.g. hillm@cambriansd.com) and password to login.

Note: If there is another username on the login screen, press the *Option* key and the *Enter* key at the same time. This will clear the login screen.

5. Mirror your display on Apple TV.

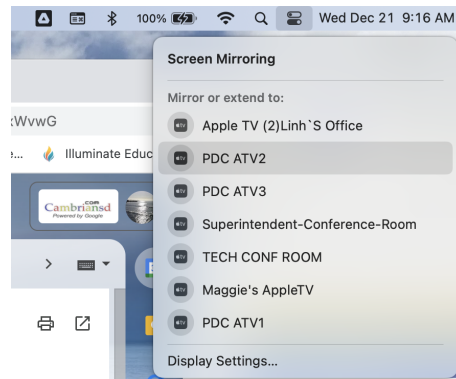
Select the *Control Center* icon in the top right of your screen on the menu bar.

Then select the *Screen Mirroring*.



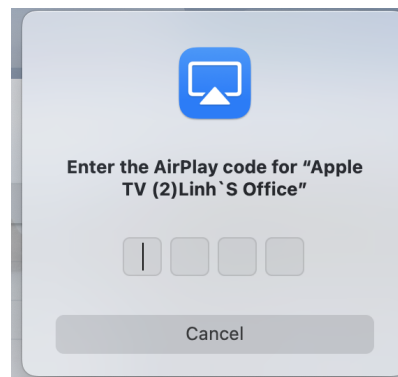
6. Choose the Apple TV your want to display to.

Usually the names will be by room # (e.g. Room 14)



7. Enter the 4 digit code

A 4 digit code will appear on the classroom TV. Enter this code in the dialog box that will appear on your computer screen.



8. You should see your computer screen displayed on the classroom TV.

If the display is really small (i.e. hard to read), follow these [steps to adjust the resolution](#).
