

# Murmurations - Seeking Developer/s

The [Murmurations](#) Project (an open protocol for data sharing and aggregation) is seeking developers to work alongside the core team.

Now that we have the [Murmurations Profile Generator](#) (MPG) and [Demo Aggregator](#) up and running pulling in the [initial schemas](#) built from shared fields in the [fields library](#), we're entering a new phase of development to create the [next few building blocks](#).

Murmurations has several different layers ideally the new developer would have a good grasp of each of these:

- An understanding of APIs - See [the Murmurations API](#)
- JSON-LD
- Interoperable data architecture

We have 3 tech stacks running using the following technologies / tools:

## **Tasks**

We have already started work on some of the next building blocks (see [the blog](#) for more details on these) and are specifically looking for help with item 2 and another front-end task for which we also have funding available i.e. someone with React and Wordpress experience.

1. Updated WordPress aggregator plugin - **Development underway**
2. React components for filterable map and directory interfaces - **Development underway - seeking developer**
3. Updated WordPress node plugin using RJSF - **Development underway**
4. Hosted aggregator back end using Kubernetes and Golang/MongoDB/Elasticsearch - **Looking for a developer - seeking developer**
5. React front-end on Vercel, with query parameter handling for embeddable map interface - **Looking for a developer - seeking developer**
