Murmurations - Seeking Developer/s

The <u>Murmurations</u> Project (an open protocol for data sharing and aggregation) is seeking developers to work alongside the core team.

Now that we have the <u>Murmurations Profile Generator</u> (MPG) and <u>Demo Aggregator</u> up and running pulling in the <u>initial schemas</u> built from shared fields in the <u>fields library</u>, we're entering a new phase of development to create the <u>next few building blocks</u>.
