General outline and financial impact

This bill reintroduces drug related offences previously repealed by the drug legalization (No More Drug Deaths or Crime) Bill 2021. Drugs pose a serious risk to public security and order, not just resultant from their effects upon consumption but also the process they are distributed under, often involving criminal groups or other such elements, many of which are global operations in nature. They are a threat to health and life of all people and the original bill legalizes has had no positive effect for there to be an argument for not discontinuing it.
