- Electronic Equipment (I-pods, mobile phones, smart watches etc) is not permitted in the exam room – please leave all electronic equipment and notes in your car.
- Students are to follow all instructions given by the supervisor.
- All exams are compulsory. Let us know about any illness/misadventure ASAP.
- Students will NOT be allowed to leave the exam room early. Please pace yourself and make the most of all allocated time.
- Please bring pens etc in a clear bag.
- Water is supplied at the Exam Centre- but please bring a clear water bottle.
- You are not required to attend classes when you don't have an exam.
- School Uniform is to be worn to all exams.
- You are not to eat in the exam room.
- Behaviour must be appropriate. Students who distract other students in any way may be asked to leave and receive zero for that exam.
- **Students need to make a genuine attempt at each of their exams. If a student is deemed to have not made a genuine attempt he/she will be required to resit the exam.**
