6.1 v12-13.

The gospel of Luke alone, present Christ retirements to pray in secret, several of them before important decisions (maybe God revealed Him how to decide during prayer (?)).

7. Discuss the passage

7.1 What does this passage say about God, Jesus or his plan?

What is the cost of being disciple:

- “Discipleship cost everything we have” Deny yourself Mk 8:34-38. Change in lifestyle to become “salt of the earth” and “light of the world”

Meaning of being apostle:

- Disciples are called apostles or “sent ones”

7.2 What does this passage say about humans/people/me?

Differences between the discipleship of Jesus and discipleship of pharisees?

- Disciples knew Jesus and saw His miracles before being called and accepting to follow and leave everything. [Bruce]
- Pharisees disciples expected men’s approval. Jesus disciples expect God’s approval. [Ernie]
- False discipleship of Pharisees who were hypocrites and imposed rules of men. Called themselves pure and impure who didn’t follow their rules. [Bruce]
- Disciples need to move to any region/nation “without fear their lives would be defiled or unpleasing to God.” [Bruce]
- Jesus sent His disciples and gave them Holy Spirit. Pharisees couldn’t.

7.3 How can I obey what this teaches? What do I need to change?

I need to pray more like Jesus. Specially before important decisions.

How to make disciples today

- Two important points [Bruce]
 - What does God want from this person?
 - Know background.
- Teaching to follow Jesus and focus on the Lord not on ourselves.
- Really following Jesus [Ernie]
- God chose the weak. The lowly things. [Phil]
- It is an honor to be disciple of Jesus.
- Not disqualified although far from perfect
- Asking God what do you want me to do
- To make good disciples I need first to be a good disciple
