


Please enter your child's first name and click Create List. You'll then see a window like this please find More in the top right hand side and click Manage List.

Please change the Privacy from Private to Public. Then scroll down the screen until you see the following:




When you've completed those three steps click Save Changes at the bottom.

When you find PRIME ELIGIBLE items you want, click it and scroll down until you see Add to List. Click that and then click the appropriate Kid's wishlist.




When you've finished adding items under \$30 that your kids would like, go back to this page:
