## Marketplace Guidelines

**Please Note:** This is our Field trip for the end of the year. We are celebrating our entrepreneurship by selling products and coming together to celebrate the end of the year. All are welcome! Don't want to sell something? Come and support your classmates by shopping at their booths!

**Registration:** You must [sign up](#) to reserve a table in order to sell items at the Marketplace. The deadline to register for a table is [May 8th](#). You do not need to register to come shop, all are welcome!

### **What is Marketplace?**

Marketplace is an annual, end of the year event that students at CAV look forward to every year. Students have the option of creating an item to sell to their school peers. Alternatively, students may create a carnival game for others to pay to play. The goal is to develop skills in entrepreneurship and make a profit!

### **Creating a Carnival Game:**

- Students may have prizes for their games. (Example: small party favor toys like sticky hands, bouncy balls, stickers, wrapped candy, etc...)
- Students should try to make a profit – consider the game and prize cost- your goal is to make money.
- Bring enough dollar bills and coins to make change for your customers.



***\*These are just a few examples; See guidelines below:***

**The following are guidelines for creating games and items to be sold:**

- Students may not sell food (including candy and drinks) due to food safety regulations. Due to the growing amount of allergies, we want everyone to be safe. Thank you for your understanding.
- All items and games must be created by students.
- Items must be sold for \$5.00 or less. Please keep in mind students are mostly purchasing, so they will not have a lot of money. If you sell an item for higher prices you may wind up with a lot of product going home with you.
- Bring enough dollar bills and quarters to make change for your customers.
- Students should make a profit – try to make twice your product cost (Ex: If your item costs \$1 to make, you should charge \$2).
- You will have half of a table to display your items or game- please plan accordingly. If you need more space than a table, please be sure to include that information when you register for your table. We will let you know if the extra space you need can be accommodated. Games will be placed in the assembly room/lobby areas. Because we will be inside, no water games are permitted.
- You can advertise with posters or flyers throughout the building in the weeks leading up to the day of the Marketplace. Please get your poster approved by the office before displaying.
- You can have a business partner to collaborate and take shifts when shopping OR you can work alone. If you leave your table unattended while you shop, please provide a “closed” sign. Parents should not be selling items or running games for students.
- Please note that if your child does not wish to sell anything or create a game, he/she can still come to the Marketplace to buy items and play games. In that case, you do not need to sign up on the Google Form.
