(Travel-Abroad Programs)

The Rotary Youth Exchange programs are among the most respected and well-developed in the world, and District 5110 has a long history of effective participation. The goal of Rotary Youth Exchange is to build world peace one young person at a time.

Students ages 15-18.5 can choose a **Long-Term Exchange** that lasts a full academic year. These exchanges are a good fit for students interested in attending high school abroad for a year while living with 2-3 host families. [Long-Term Exchange info sheet](#). Rotary also offers **Short Term (family-to-family) Exchanges** lasting six to eight weeks when school is not in session. In this program, U.S. students ages 15-19 live with a host family (that has its own high-school student) in July 2026 and then host the student they lived with in their own home during August 2026. New Generations Service Exchanges offer additional opportunities for small groups and young individuals up to age 30 to participate in service and vocational exchanges lasting from a few weeks to six months.
