Del Webb Chromebook Set-Up & Expectations

How do I log into my new chromebook?

Your login will be your CCSD email address.

Are you a returning CCSD student? Use your previous login and password from last school year.

How do I reset my password or obtain my email address?

You must be on campus and using school Wi-Fi to reset your password or to claim your account! To reset your password, go to https://myaccount.ccsd.net and select the blue box that says "reset your password." Please follow the instructions to create a new, secure password. Write your new password down and keep it in a safe place! If you are brand new to the Clark County School District and need to find your email address, go to https://myaccount.ccsd.net and select the blue box that says "claim your account." Then click the blue box that says "students." You will need to enter your name, birthdate, and student number. Claiming your account can only be done once!

What accounts should I be able to access on the first day of school?

You will want to review how to access your gmail so you can check important emails from teachers and the Del Webb staff. https://mail.google.com

How do I connect to Wi-Fi at home?

Turn on Wi-Fi

- 1. At the bottom right, select the time.
- 2. Select Not Connected. Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.
- 3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.

Pick a network and connect

- 1. Connect to an open network
 - a. Select the Wi-Fi network.
 - b. Remember, your information might be visible to other people on this network.
- 2. Connect to a secure network
 - a. Select the secure Wi-Fi network.
 - b. Type the network password.
 - c. Select connect.

Important Reminders & Expectations:

- 1. If your chromebook is lost or stolen on campus, you must make a report in the SSO, SBT, and with school police.
- 2. If your chromebook is stolen off campus, you <u>must</u> make a report with the SSO, SBT, and file a police report with the local police.
- 3. Your chromebook is to be in the provided carrying case <u>at all times</u>! Students will receive behavior infractions for not having their chromebook in a case. If any damage or technician issues occur, report to room 902 <u>immediately</u> to speak with Mr. McGowan or Mr. Robinson. Fines will be assessed for damage incurred.
- 4. Chromebook chargers are **NOT** allowed on campus. Your charger is to remain at home and you are expected to bring a fully charged chromebook with you each day to class.
- 5. At the end of the school year or during student withdrawal from Del Webb Middle School, you are <u>required to</u> <u>return the chromebook, case, charger, and cell phone pouch in good condition</u> to the Librarian or SBT. Fines will be assessed for missing or damaged items.
