



Segment: ICT Olympiad

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to all currently enrolled BAIUST students, regardless of department or semester.
2. Participants must complete the registration process before the specified deadline.

Competition Format

1. The quiz will be conducted in an individual format.
2. The quiz will consist of **Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)** and **Short Questions** based on Information and Communication Technology (ICT), general technology, digital awareness, and related topics.
3. The duration of the quiz is **30 minutes** and the total number of **questions** will be **30**.

Marking System

1. Each correct answer will carry the assigned marks.
2. There will be **no negative marking** for incorrect answers.
3. Multiple answered questions will receive zero marks.

Examination Rules

1. Participants must arrive at the venue at least 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time.
2. Mobile phones, smart watches, tablets, earphones, calculators, or any other electronic devices are strictly prohibited during the examination.
3. All electronic devices must be switched off and kept away before the quiz starts.
4. Participants are not allowed to communicate, exchange materials, or seek assistance from others during the competition.
5. Any form of cheating, use of unfair means, or possession of unauthorized materials will result in immediate **disqualification**.

Fair Play and Discipline

1. A fair and friendly competitive environment must be maintained at all times.
2. Participants must follow the instructions of the organizers and invigilators.
3. Any disruptive behavior, misconduct, or attempt to disturb other participants may lead to penalties or disqualification.
4. Participants are expected to maintain proper decorum throughout the event.

Results and Tie-Breaking

1. Participants will be ranked according to their total scores.
2. In the event of a tie, a tie-breaker round or additional questions may be conducted at the discretion of the organizing committee.
3. The decision of the judges and organizing committee shall be final and binding.

General Instructions

1. Question papers and answer sheets must be submitted before leaving the examination venue.
2. Participants are not permitted to join the competition after 10 minutes of the start time.

Syllabus

1. Questions will be based on the HSC ICT syllabus.
2. Complex mathematics and programming questions will not be included.
3. A few recent technology-related General Knowledge (GK) questions will also be included.
