Application Instructions

The schools are currently recruiting students in grades **Kindergarten through 7th Grade**. This application can be delivered with an original signature via any of the following options:

- **Dropped off** in person during school hours

Deadline & Lottery

The application deadline is **April 4th, 2025 at 5:00PM**. **Applications received by the deadline will be submitted into the lottery, which will be held April 9, 2025 at 11am virtual zoom. Link will be provided as the day gets near.** Results will be mailed to all applicants. Applications received after the deadline will be added to the waitlist, at which point students will be accepted on a rolling basis.

Acceptance Process

Acceptance is decided by a random lottery. Each school will give preferences to the following categories of pupils, in the following order of priority:

1. Siblings of currently enrolled students
2. Students indicating on this admissions application that they speak a language other than English at home (Kindergarten); **or** are currently receiving English Language Learner services (Grade 1-7), with priority given to those students who live in Community School District 1
3. Students who primarily speak English at home and live within Community School District 1
4. All other eligible students entering Kindergarten through 8th Grade

The above preferences will be absolute preferences. The exception is the second preference, which will be a set aside of at least 20% of the available seats in each grade that is open for enrollment for applicants who indicate on their admissions application that they speak primarily a language other than English at home or are currently receiving English Language Learner services.

Non-Discrimination Statement: A charter school shall not discriminate against any student or limit the admission of any student on the basis of ethnicity, national origin, gender, disability, intellectual ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, athletic ability, disability, race, creed, gender, national origin, religion or ancestry or any other ground that would be unlawful if done by a school. A school may not require any action by a student or family (such as an admissions test, interview, essay, attendance at an information session, etc.) in order for an applicant to either receive or submit an application for admission to that school.
