Description

Data from the Ministry of Communication and Information of the Republic of Indonesia revealed that throughout 2019-2021, the Financial Services Authority or OJK recorded more than 19,000 public complaints regarding illegal online loans, and 47% came from DKI Jakarta. One of the causes is the lack of public knowledge and awareness of the dangers of illegal online loans. For this reason, the Vocational Education Program held a **Socialization of Illegal Online Loan Alertness on Panggang Island, Seribu Islands Regency, DKI Jakarta on August 19, 2023**. This community service provides education to residents to be able to recognize and be aware of illegal online loans so that they can be avoided, and educates those who have been involved in online loans to make complaints to the Financial Services Authority (OJK) as a solution. With this community service activity, it is hoped that the community will become smart in detecting and understanding the dangers of illegal online loans, the community has adequate and sufficient knowledge in interacting with the digital world, especially those related to the economic sector such as online loans that are currently disturbing, and the community is aware not to be easily influenced by advertisements that offer fast loans through online media.
