



Resolution in Support of the “Ramadan Proclamation” Issued by the City of San Diego

Whereas, the County of San Diego has a diverse, involved, and active Muslim community of many cultural backgrounds, and Muslims have been key and essential staff, from the medical field to the service industry, in helping San Diego recover from the COVID-19 Pandemic; and Muslims have been key contributors to the social movement of justice and fair inclusion for all; and Muslim residents of this county, with their hard work and contributions to medicine, science, information technology, education, and many other fields, have enriched San Diego County’s culture and economy; and

Whereas, Ramadan is a month when Muslims grow, build communally, and aid those in need and marks an annual spiritual renewal for each individual, a reason to celebrate and express gratitude; and the spirit of Ramadan is centered on the intention to practice acts of kindness and support for our most vulnerable, as well as individual and collective worship; and

Whereas, our San Diego Muslim community are currently observing this month of Ramadan, which was recognized by San Diego Mayor Todd Gloria and all 9 San Diego City Council Members ceremoniously on April 12, 2022;

Therefore be it resolved, that the San Diego County Democratic Party supports the Proclamation issued by the City of San Diego on April 12, 2022 proclaiming April 2022 to be “Ramadan Month” and

Be it further resolved, that the San Diego County Democratic Party recognizes the month of Ramadan and its concluding festival known as Eid al-Fitr (“Festival of Breaking the Fast”) as significant and joyous occasions for San Diego County’s Muslim population.
