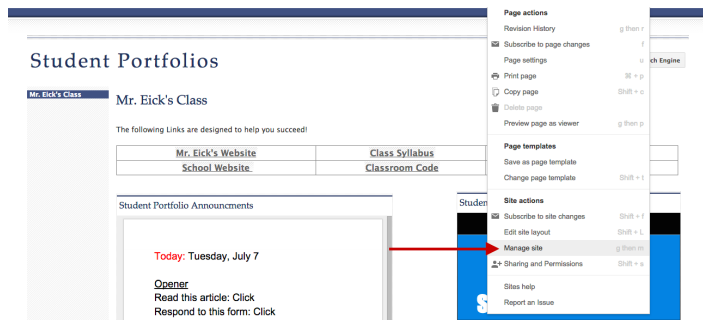
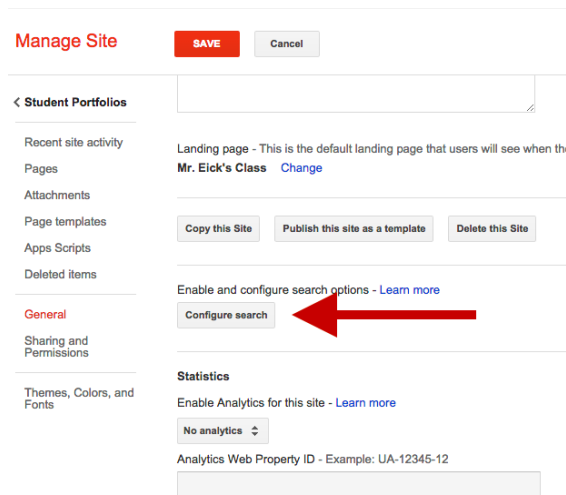


Embed Custom Search Engine in a Google Site

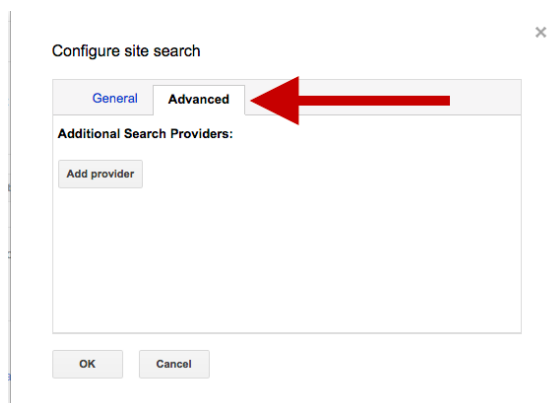
1. Click on Sprocket>Manage Site



2. Click Configure Search



3. Click on Advanced



4. Select Google Custom Search from the top box.
Next, Name the Search Engine
Finally, paste the URL for your search engine.

NOTE: You may have to copy and paste the following.

The URL breaks into two parts, the root URL, and the custom URL that includes everything from “cx=” to the end. The root URL, depending on your organization, may have an error. If so, copy the root below and add it to your custom URL.

Copy this: <http://www.google.com/cse/home?>
Then paste your custom URL code after the “?”.

The final copy will look like this:

<http://www.google.com/cse/home?>(ADD YOUR URL HERE STARTING WITH CX)
