Advanced Education/Academic Enrichment

- Are you considering Dual Enrollment for Spring semester? [Visit the Guidance page of Hub for the required forms and next steps](#), and meet with your Counselor to get approval form signed.
- Important reminders:
 - Form must be completed in ink.
 - Recommend having 2-4 classes on form (desired course section and alternates).
 - Check to see if there are any prerequisites.
 - Check "restricted list" (Sierra only).
- **Sierra College** is now **FREE**. Spring schedule is available [HERE](#). **Registration opens Nov 16th.**
- **Los Rios** spring schedule will be available [HERE](#) in Late October. **Registration opens December 14-15th (and onwards).**
- **Dual Enrollment: Students must submit an Official Transcript for all course work completed at a Community College to their Counselor or ST to receive credit.**
- **Sacramento State Accelerated College Entrance program (ACE)**
 - Must be a Junior or Senior with a 3.0 GPA (or higher), with SAT scores of 550 in Math or Critical Reading or a combined score of 1100 in the two areas. See counselor for details!
