Current Text:

Article III

Section 2. Executive Board: There shall be an Executive Board composed of the state chairs, the state officers and their designated adult sponsors, the chair of each standing committee, and the president of the Indiana Senior Classical League or an I.S.C.L. member appointed by the president. This board shall act as the agent through which business of this organization may be transacted between annual meetings. The president of the Indiana Junior Classical League shall act as chair. The Executive Board shall also name an advisor who shall supervise and sponsor the publication of the state newspaper.

Proposed Text:

Section 2. Executive Board: There shall be an Executive Board composed of the state chairs, the state officers and their designated adult sponsors, the chair of each standing committee, and the president of the Indiana Senior Classical League or an I.S.C.L. member appointed by the president. In the case that the I.S.C.L. President cannot attend, the highest ranking I.S.C.L. officer in attendance shall act in the I.S.C.L. President's place. This board shall act as the agent through which business of this organization may be transacted between annual meetings. The president of the Indiana Junior Classical League shall act as chair. The Executive Board shall also name an advisor who shall supervise and sponsor the publication of the state newspaper.

Rationale:

This gives the I.S.C.L. equal representation on the board if their president is unable to attend. The I.S.C.L. has representation on the board through the I.S.C.L. Advisor as well.
