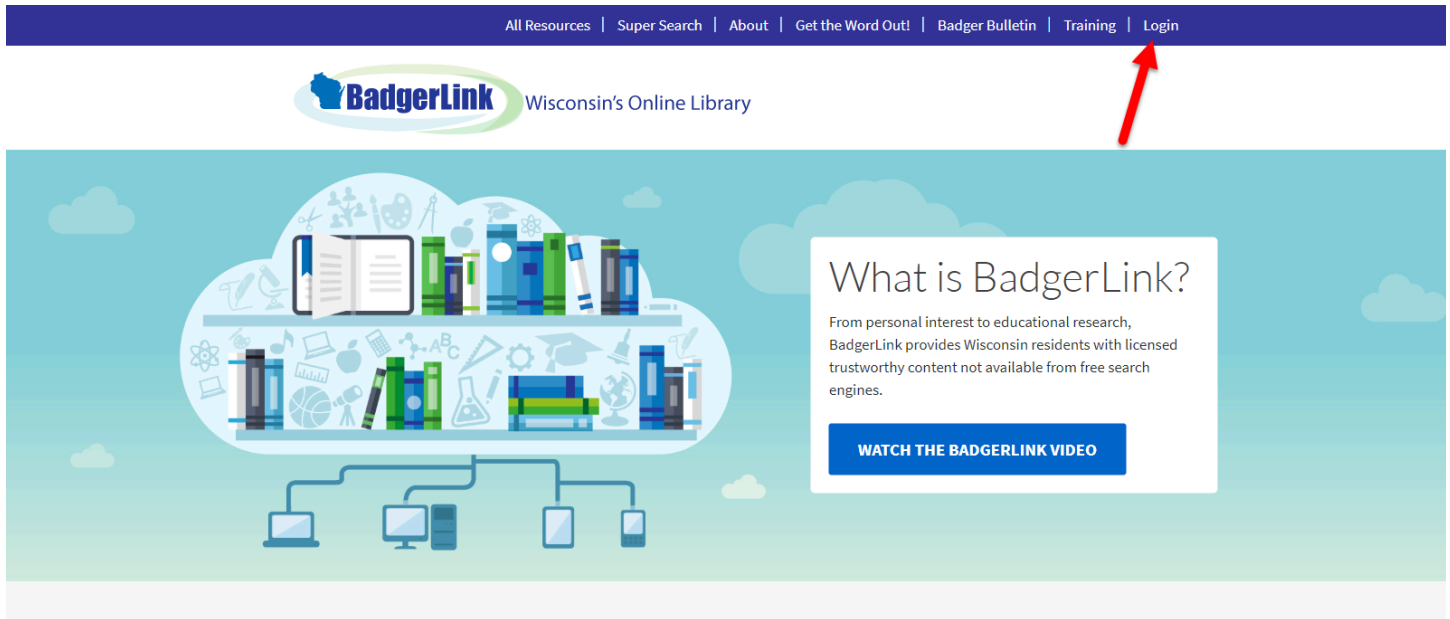


## Accessing BadgerLink Resources at Home Lakeland Union High School

Begin at the BadgerLink website <https://badgerlink.dpi.wi.gov> and select the Login option in the upper right menu. **NOTE:** You must log in each day you would like to use the resources.



### On the Login page:

1. Select “Minocqua - Lakeland Union High School” from the dropdown
2. Enter **luhs** > click Login
