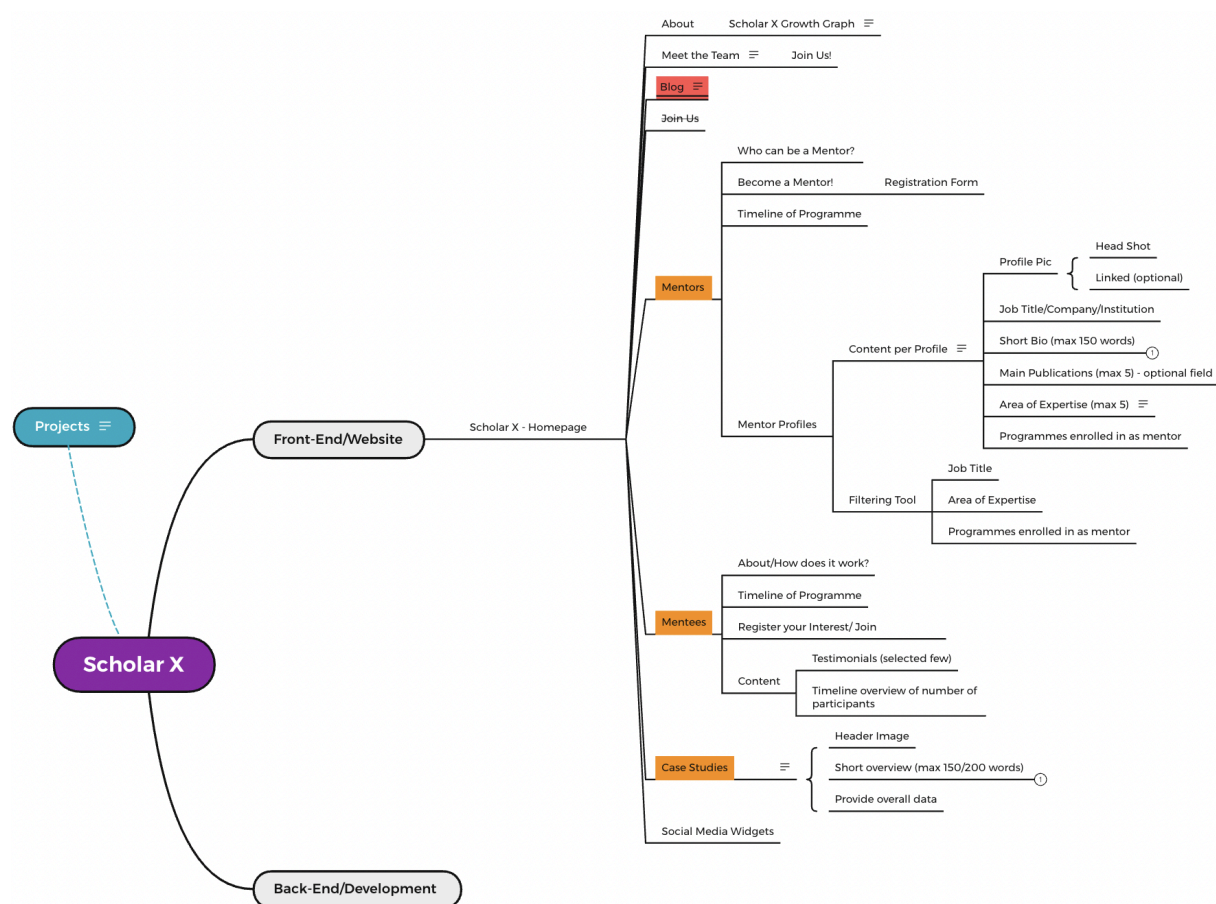


Scholar X – V1 (in-progress) - Front-End/Website

Blog

Also are these Mentee Profiles? If so, then you should put them under the Mentees section and insert a filtering system. It would be good to have a look at formatting the way things are displayed uniformly.
