Over the last two weeks, we have been considering our identity as children of God (1 John 3:1). As God's children we are to exhibit His character and nature.

We looked at how we do this by being:

- lights in this dark world (Philippians 2:14, 15)
- holy and living in the fear of God (1 Peter 1:14-19).

This coming Sunday (19 Nov) we will reflect on another aspect of being children of God: A Father's Discipline. (Hebrews 12:4-11). Please meditate on this passage and come prepared to share.
