

CALL FOR WORKS

***Sociological Review* LIX (4) / 2025 THEMATIC SECTION "Svetozar Marković: 150th death anniversary – on the importance and scope of his ideas"**

The Editorial Board of the *Sociological Review* is inviting all researchers to give their contribution to the research of social theories emerging in our territories and of the history of Serbian sociology in their papers dedicated to the 150th death anniversary of Svetozar Marković (1846-1875).

The initiation of this thematic section has been motivated by the firm belief of the editor that Svetozar Marković, in the beginning a contemporary of and influenced by Russian agrarian socialists such as Nikolay Chernyshevsky, and then a communist of Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels, witnessed epochal historical events, e.g., the Paris Commune from 1871, at the time of the First International, while today his ideas may also be of great significance for understanding society, its trends and people's emancipation.

We will welcome all papers from the aspect of all topics and spheres dealt with by Marković, which may be said to have echoes in modern research of social sciences as well, particularly when it comes to Serbian and Balkan circumstances, but certainly not limited only to them. A permanently open theoretical and practical question is how to achieve the transformation of insufficiently educated working people so that they are able to understand the mechanisms of their exploitation, into self-aware self-governors of their social communities at local and regional levels of the "Balkan Federation", advocated by Marković, as a road for overcoming the contradictions of capital accumulation for the needs of accumulation itself, rather than fulfilling the real needs of working people.
