 - Board is continuing to discuss the situation.
- Architectural committee status
 - **The board would like to remind the community that the Architectural Committee should be consulted before any remodeling projects are started.**
- Trail sub-committee and open space status
 - Discing originally scheduled for end of April but is postponed due to rains.
 - The weeds by the signs will be cleared after the rains stop.
 - **The board would like to remind the residents that they should clear their property of dried vegetation and weeds prior to the peak summer season for fire safety.**
- Treasurer update including candidate/handoff
 - Board will follow up on a HOA fee that wasn't paid for one house for 2025.
 - **Any residents that have not paid the annual HOA fees for 2026 are requested to pay the fees immediately with an additional 10% late fee penalty of \$162.**
 - Board approves the budget for 2026 (will be shared with the community during the annual meeting).
- Annual Meeting planning and election set up for new board members
 - Anna will reach out to the community to seek volunteers to replace John Chang as Treasurer.
 - Annual meeting date will be June 28, 2026 which is later than usual due to non-availability of board members.
 - The board has decided that the community will be polled every two years on whether PRHOA should continue with security for the community. The next poll will be in 2027.
- July 4th planning
 - The board applied for permits for closing roads for fire safety reasons (Tom Costello helped last year).
 - Need to work with security company to set up the barricades

- Hans Hartmann case status:
 - A summary judgement in the [Quote Case Matter] in the Board's favor. Subsequent trial dates set for early 2027.
 - The board is engaged in conversation with both Hans Hartmann and the Hasans.
- Connector road email from Haresh Patel about access to connector road
 - The connector road is the private property collectively by all Parker Ranch residents and they all have access to the road as well all Parker open space areas.
- Architectural committee status
 - An ADU is being built by the owners of 12665 Star Ridge Ct. are building an ADU which has been approved by the Architectural Committee
- Trail sub-committee and open space status
 - There seems to be an increase in trash along trails and the board has discussed reporting this to the city
 - Tree has fallen down into the valley near Star Ridge Court. Board has taken action to remove the tree.
 - **The board would like to remind the community about the importance of taking care of trees and shrubs on your property.**
 - Yearly discing: Walk through rather than map may be more effective in ensuring all areas are properly disced.
- Access to Flock camera footage by residents
 - The board will decide on a case-by-case basis whether access is provided using security considerations as a criterion
- Lights at the four entrances not working as well
 - Board has upgraded the solar lights with more powerful solar lights.
- Treasurer update
 - Less than 50% of residents have paid annual dues.
