The theme will be what clues do Palaeontologists use to establish how particular dinosaurs moved. A short break will then be followed by an engaging hands-on session called Dinosaur Locomotion where students, acting as junior Palaeontologists, will evaluate a series of clues including fossil evidence and the comparative movement of modern day creatures.
