
Sharing your screen from a Chromebook during a Zoom meeting



If you are a student participating in remote learning, you might need to share your Chromebook's screen during a Zoom meeting.

Find the Share button

During the Zoom meeting, you should see a green "Share" button at the bottom of the window.



If you do not see the Share button, it may be that the meeting host has not enabled participants to share their videos. The host would need to enable sharing by clicking on their "Security" button and selecting "Allow participants to: Share Screen".

To Share your screen

- 1. Click the green "Share" button.
- 2. Choose whether you wish to share your entire computer screen (**Desktop**) or just the content from a single tool (**Application**).
- 3. In the pop-up, select the correct Desktop or Application and click the blue **Share** button
 - The other participants in the Zoom meeting can now see your Chromebook screen (or shared application.)
- 4. When you want to stop sharing your screen, click the red "**Stop Sharing**" option at the top of the screen. You will return to the Zoom meeting.

NOTE: While screen sharing, you will **not** be able to see the other participants' **videos** in the Zoom meeting. Unlike LPS teacher laptops (MacBook Air), Chromebooks do not have the processing power required to allow you to share your screen and also see participant cameras at the same time.
