

Instructions for Authors

Biography Requirements

The biography should be written in **the third person** and be concise. A length of between **100 and 150 words** is suggested. It must be written in **Spanish and English** (both languages are required). **Each co-author must submit their own biography.** It must include the following elements:

- **Academic degree and profession:** For example: Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering.
- **Institutional affiliation:** Name of the institution and department where the author currently works.
- **Research interests:** Areas of expertise or topics of scientific interest.
- **Notable achievements:** Such as the SNII (indicate level), articles published in peer-reviewed and indexed journals in the last five years, or recent academic awards and recognitions.
- **Contact and networks:** Include a link to your **ORCID** profile (**required**) and an institutional email address. It is also recommended to include links to profiles on **Google Scholar, ResearchGate, or Scopus Author ID**, if available.

To maintain the journal's professional appearance, the image must meet the following requirements:

Criterion	Specification
Format	JPG or PNG. Minimum 300 dpi or file size greater than 1 MB.
Framing	Medium shot (chest up) or close-up (face).
Background	Preferably plain, light-colored, or a blurred office/lab setting.
Quality	Avoid selfies, cropped photos from social events, or pixelated images.
Attire	Formal or business attire.
