Does your proposed work address critical issues of national relevance, such as economic growth, health, environmental sustainability, or technological innovation in the U.S?		
Is your proposed work expected to create widespread benefits on a national scale, either economically or in terms of societal impact (e.g., creating jobs, improving public welfare, advancing technologies)?		
Do you have a well-documented, actionable plan (including timelines, goals, and milestones) to execute your proposed endeavor in the U.S.?		
Do you have prior experience, collaborations, or partnerships that will help you in achieving your goals in the U.S?		
Can your work lead to direct or indirect job creation, industry growth, or economic advancement in the U.S.?		

Can your work lead to new business formation, entrepreneurship opportunities, or startup growth in the U.S.?		
Have you identified specific sectors or industries that will specifically benefit from your work in the U.S.?		
Do you have confirmed funding sources, infrastructure, or strategic collaborations in place to support your endeavor in the U.S.?		
Have you considered potential challenges in executing your plan and developed strategies to address them?		
Do you have the necessary academic qualifications, a degree, diploma, certificate, or similar award from a college, university, school, or other recognition that demonstrates your exceptional ability in your field?		
Do you have the license to practice your profession or certification for your profession or occupation		

Do you have letters from current or former employers documenting your occupation?		
Have you received recognition, awards, or accomplishments that distinguish you from others in your industry?		
Has your work led to measurable improvements or advancements in your field (e.g., new technologies, patents, research findings)?		
Have you contributed to the development or education of others in your field through mentorship or collaboration?		
Have you been involved in reviewing the work of others in your field (e.g., serving as a peer reviewer for publications, conferences, or awards)?		
Have independent experts in your field (not just colleagues or employers) recognized your work as nationally significant?		
Are you a member of any professional associations that require outstanding achievements or		

demonstrated excellence for entry and not just membership fees?		
Do you have letters of recommendation from highly regarded experts or organizations in your industry attesting to the importance of your work and at least a few who are independent (i.e., not former employers, supervisors, or collaborators)?		
Have your contributions been cited, referenced, or acknowledged by experts, researchers, or government entities in your field?		
Has your work been featured in any reputable media outlets (e.g., journals, newspapers, online platforms)?		
Have you received public recognition or acknowledgment for your expertise in any publications or reports?		
If your proposed endeavour will include a startup owned by you, do you have financial records backing it up such as revenue, investment from others and other funding types?		

Do you have comprehensive and detailed documentation to support the claims made in this questionnaire about your work and its national importance?		
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Notes:

1. The National Interest Waiver requires evidence that your work will benefit the U.S. substantially.
2. You should be well position to execute the proposed endeavor you are presenting
3. Include specific, verifiable documentation to support your claims.

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
