

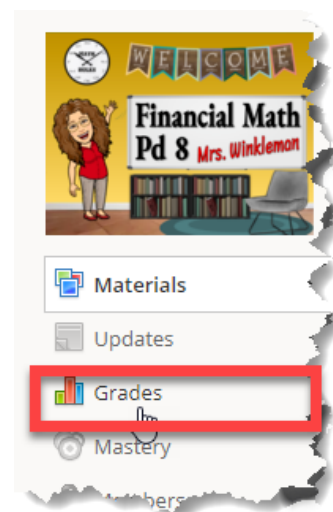
Understanding Checking Your Grades

Assignments Column

This column lists all current assignments. Each title is linked to the assignment's page. Click on the Assignment Title to go to the assignment.

Due Date Column

This column lists next to the assignment title the date an assignment is/was due.

Grade Points Column

This column displays if an assignment has been graded and how many points have been received.

- Reading Points: grades are listed as **points received / total points available**.
- Dash Line and no points: the assignment has either not been submitted or has not been graded yet.

- Incomplete: —  Incomplete - the assignment has been marked as incomplete and is missing but does not count towards the course grade
- Missing: 0  Missing - the assignment is missing and has a grade of zero
