The Learning City: Ōtautahi Christchurch

Actionable interventions

The actions outlined below serve as an initial roadmap to realise the vision of transforming Ōtautahi Christchurch into a learning city.

Programs and initiatives

- Learning passport program that rewards residents for participating in various learning experiences.
- Learning ambassador program to recruit learning advocates to facilitate discussions and promote learning opportunities.
- **Pop-up learning spaces** offering classes and workshops in public areas.
- Learning discounts with local businesses to encourage patrons to participate in learning activities.

Education & lifelong learning

- **Open a charter school with no walls** to promote learning beyond traditional classrooms, using the city as a learning environment.
- **Support schools** with fostering curiosity, collaboration, and a love for learning within their cultures.

- **Citywide public art campaign** with art installations that depict learning in all its forms.
- **Make transport a learning opportunity** by including learning spaces and content in buses, trains, and trams.
- A Learning City award to recognise individuals, businesses, and organisations that contribute to lifelong learning.
- **Tell inspiring stories** of people transforming their lives through learning.
- Build and activate a central city learning hub that supports diverse community engagement
- Recognise that learning extends beyond formal settings by facilitating learning and upskilling in every environment.

- Embrace creative expression and diverse learning pathways by funding and creating opportunities for young people in art and entertainment

Infrastructure & resources

- Enable exploration of Ōtautahi by developing digital assets to enhance learning and engagement with the city's history, culture, and natural spaces.
- Create learner centric funding so that funding is a tool that enables easier scaffolding of learning opportunities.
- Equity & inclusion
 - Create more diverse learning opportunities by promoting inclusive pathways that address the needs of every learner.
 - Ensure walkable access to fresh food by 2030 to help address basic needs that underpin wellbeing and learning.
- Sustainability & environment
 - Provide a walk on water sensitivity to promote ecological awareness and foster responsibility for the environment.
 - Integrate sustainability into all aspects of the learning city by adopting an Earth-first approach

 Drive equitable transport & housing plans which ensure access to essential resources and services required for effective learning.

- **Promote inclusive learning across sectors** by dismantling barriers and ensuring access for all.

Develop themed learning trails that guide residents and visitors to sites of historical, cultural, scientific, or artistic significance.

Community & engagement

- **Continuously engage the community,** ensuring the learning city vision remains consistent with the values and aspirations of all of our people.
- **Create a distinct brand identity** for the city as a learning destination.
- Hold an annual citywide learning festival to celebrate learning in all its forms and showcase the diversity of learning opportunities in the city.
- **Support local learning** through platforming existing initiatives and fostering collaboration.

Fostering effective leadership

- **Model and facilitate leadership** which effectively drives positive change.
- Support the wellbeing of education leaders through recognition of informal networks and support systems.
