

# Everything you can do for 100 Days within a Local Group (LG)

#### → Get your LG into shape

100 Days is all about growing numbers!

From years of local organising, we know that it's very difficult for LGs to grow when the basics aren't in place. However, you're in luck - we've done the work of listing all those basics for you.

So you can now check out the <u>100 Days planning template</u> to go through a short LG checklist and find out how to get help with it if needed.

## → Mobilise for 100 Days and recruit for your LG!

LGs won't mobilise 100,000 people on their own. XR will use media mobilisation methods and collaborate with other organisations to make 100 Days a success. But without LGs, it will be impossible to get 100,000 people to Parliament!

The primary aim of our outreach is to get sympathetic people in our communities signed up **to join us around Parliament between 21st-24th April**. If they're keen, you can also get them involved in your LG - the more there are, the more beautiful the rebellion grows and the more can get done!

In the past year, Project 3.5 has helped refocused the movement on the importance of reaching out to our own communities, having face-to-face conversations, and getting them involved in XR. Project 3.5 will continue to support LGs with their mobilisation efforts for 100 Days. It doesn't mean you have to go door-knocking or organise talks.





The latest 3.5 guidance is tailored to the needs of the 100 Days campaign and there's something in it for every LG.


## → Actions for 100 Days and The Big One

## 100 Days How you can invite people to The Big One

#### In 10 minutes

We have to act urgently because we're running out of time. There are climate disasters playing out around the world and they are the result of the last ten, twenty, thirty years of emissions. We knew then, we did nothing. We know now and our leaders are still doing nothing. At the last COP in Egypt there was zero progress made on emissions reduction. 2022 will be another record year.

To stay anywhere near 1.5 or even 2 degrees of warming, we must halve emissions by 2030. Knowing this, governments, including ours, are supporting huge new fossil fuel projects over the next decade. Ecosystems are collapsing. Millions are facing famine and forced migration.

In the UK we're experiencing an energy, cost of living, wage and working conditions crisis while fossil fuel companies make unprecedented profits with support and public money from our government.

People know that things must change. They're terrified of what the future holds for them and their families, but what can they do? Politicians, business leaders, corporations and newspaper owners are committed to staying on the path we're on.

As individuals, we feel powerless. But we're not alone.

What we're suggesting is a way for anyone and everyone to take part in a massive act of compassionate civil resistance against this failure of responsible leadership.

A recent survey showed that 66% of the public support non-violent direct action to protect the environment. But we know that many people feel uncomfortable about directly targeting the public with disruption and many are hesitant about taking part in civil disobedience because they don't identify as an 'activist'.

In April 2023 XR will go to Parliament and nowhere else. We will occupy roads but only those immediately around the Houses of Parliament.

And this isn't about identity. Everybody cares - about their family, their future, their home, about nature and about the most basic of all rights: to live. Something has gone wrong. That care,
