## I. TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAMS (TPP)

HHS/OASH/OPA

[The Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program](#), administered by the Office of Adolescent Health (OAH), is *defined* as an “*evidence-based*”\* grant program which funds comprehensive sex education programs for children aged 10 to 19.

## II. ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAMS (APP) HHS/ACF/FYSB

[Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Programs](#) administered by the Family and Youth Services Bureau (FYSB), provide grants for sex education programs that are sometimes called “abstinence plus” programs which focus on [“both abstinence and contraception,”](#) [“emphasize risk avoidance](#) teaching youth to voluntarily refrain from non-marital sexual activity,” and “abstinence education and mentoring to [promote abstinence](#).”

**WARNING:** While grant requirements may state that *curricula/programs* are to “**promote abstinence**” and “**emphasize risk avoidance**” in order to receive funding, content analyses show that [many programs](#) **normalize teen sex, encourage sexual pleasure-seeking, condone early sexual debut and promote high-risk sexual behaviors rather than promote abstinence.** [Read more...](#)

DASH works to **protect and improve the health of youth** by:

- Collecting and **analyzing** data that drive action.
- **Translating science** into innovative programs and tools that protect youth.
- Supporting a network of leaders in primary prevention by funding education agencies that reach nearly two million students.
