Glossary	
pet	An animal that people keep in their homes for fun or friendship.
farm animal	An animal that lives on a farm and helps people or gives food.
insect	A very small animal with 6 legs and often wings.
Wild animal	An animal that lives in nature, not in homes or on farms.

GRAMMAR: Am/is/are vs regular verbs (Present Simple)



Here's a table to help you remember how to use **am**, **is** and **are**:

	Singular	Plural
First person	I am	we are
Second person	you are	you are
Third person	he is	they are
	she is	they are
	it is	they are

Learn these short forms called contractions:

I am	=	I'm	they are	=	they're
you are	=	you're	we are	=	we're
he is	=	he's			
she is	=	she's			
it is	=	it's			
am not	=	aren't (only in questions)			
is not	=	isn't			
are not	=	aren't			


In questions, use **aren't** as a contraction of **am not**. For example, you can say:

I'm taller than you, **aren't** I?

But in a statement you say:

I'm **not** as old as you.

Use the verb **is** with singular nouns and **are** with plural nouns.



The camel **is** a desert animal.



Vegetables and fruit **are** healthy foods.




