What you will need for the class:

Paper:

- 9x12 or 11x 14 drawing paper pad
- Optional: Pastel Paper (Like Canson) or Sanded Pastel Paper

Pencils:

2B & 4B Pencils (Faber Castell, Blick, Tombow, Kimberly, or generals)

Erasers:

- white vinyl eraser
- mechanical eraser/ detail eraser (i.e., Tombow mono knock 3.8) (optional)
- can be substituted with a pink eraser on the back of a pencil (optional)

Sharpeners:

- preferably one that has a "shavings catcher"
- electric pencil sharpener (optional)

Colored Pencils:

- Preferably Prismacolor set (they blend best), they are in between the price of student grade and artist grade colored pencils - (72 set is often the best deal, but you can start with a smaller set.)
- Or you can use student grade if Prismacolors are too pricy, like Sargent art, Castle Art, Arteza, etc.
- Also, it's good to get a "Prismacolor colorless blender pencil"

Oil Pastels:

- Thick or thin Oil Pastels (Thick are better for big areas, thin are better for details), such as Cray Pas, Faber Castell, Pentel, etc.
- Colorless blender oil pastel (optional)

Please note: No Soft or Chalk Pastels in this class.
