Parent Reaction Venn Diagram

Venn diagram Directions: In your Venn diagram, you are going to compare and contrast each family's experience as they wait for news about their children. Some chapters focus on the Cappelles, other chapters on the Montagues, and still others show the parents interacting.

Steps

1. Draw a giant Venn Diagram on your construction paper. One circle should be labeled "Cappelles" and the other should be labeled "Montagues." Make sure that this is neat and that I can read your answers.
2. Read the questions below and put the answers on the diagram. Make sure to cite page numbers in order to support your answers.
 - When did both sets of parents start suspecting their children were missing?
 - What is the first thing they do after this?
 - What do they assume happened?
 - Whom do they blame?
 - How do they feel?
 - How do they act towards each other?
3. On the back or bottom of the construction paper, respond to the following questions:
 - How are the Cappelles and Montagues similar?
 - What theme could you attach to this moment in the book? (Remember that a theme is a debatable message, not just a topic!)
