Ebony M. Glover, PhD is an Associate Professor of Neuroscience at Kennesaw State University and co-author of Psychology in Your Life (5e). A behavioral neuroscientist, she studies the neurobiology of fear, emotion regulation, and trauma-related disorders, with a focus on sex differences and women’s mental health. She has served as PI on NIH-funded biomedical research and has published in leading peer-reviewed journals. Dr. Glover contributes to the teaching community through evidence-based pedagogy and Scholarship of Teaching and Learning, particularly around neuroscience concepts. In her courses, she embeds course-based undergraduate research experiences (CUREs), student-generated lab exercises, and real-world demonstrations to make research accessible and personally relevant. She also translates science for public audiences, including a TEDxAtlanta talk on why sex differences matter for mental health.
