SUMMARY

College Connect Volunteers work closely with the College Ministry Team Leader and are responsible for helping to disciple a group of Downtown Cornerstone Church College students into maturity in Christ and life in the church.

COMMITMENT

- Serve weekly or bi-weekly, one hour per week
- Participate in College Connect Hangouts: 1-2 hours per month
- Commit to a one-year term, with an evaluation of continuance towards the end of that year.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Volunteers must be members who have participated with the church for 6+ months
- Prayerfully seeking after Jesus daily (John 15:7)
- Regularly gathering with Jesus' church (Hebrews 10:24-25), aiming to miss no more than one Sunday a month.
- Giving sacrificially, regularly, and cheerfully. (2 Corinthians 9:6-7).
- Participating in consistent discipling relationships within DCC (Hebrews 3:12-14).
- Have a passion for welcoming new students and building relationships with existing students.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Pray regularly for the College team, students, and overall ministry.
- Work with the College Ministry Leader on implementing a vision of discipleship and connection with College students.
- Facilitating weekly to bi-weekly meetings through prayer, scripture, discussion questions, and life-on-life accountability.
