

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR THE KLITZ/LINZMEYER SCHOLARSHIP
2025-2026**

Background:

The Klitz/Linzmeyer Scholarship Committee invites Marion and Gillett High School seniors pursuing a higher education degree to submit applications for scholarship consideration.

James Klitz taught mathematics in the Neenah Joint School District for 34 years and attended Marion High School. Armand Linzmeyer taught mathematics in the Neenah Joint School District for 35 years and attended Gillett High School.

One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded and will be renewable for one additional year (i.e., \$2000 total award).

The first year's scholarship monies will be paid to the recipient and to the student's school upon enrollment in the 2nd semester or quarter of the 2026-2027 collegiate year. The second year's scholarship monies will be paid to the recipient and to the student's school upon enrollment in the 2nd semester or quarter of the 2027-2028 collegiate year. Proof of enrollment should be provided to the contact information below.

Eligibility Requirements

1. The student must be a Marion or Gillett High School senior whose permanent residence is in the Marion or Gillett School District.
2. The student must attend a college, university or trade school that is part of a system leading to a minimum 2-year degree.
3. The student must rank in the top 50% of the High School graduating class based on the cumulative grade point average during his/her high school years.
4. The student must pursue a "math-related" higher education degree. Science, healthcare, finance, electrician and other degrees using substantial mathematics will be considered.
5. The criteria for final selection will be financial need, community service (including extracurricular activities), and academic record.

Application Procedure

1. Complete the Klitz/Linzmeyer Scholarship application.
2. Provide a transcript of credits and grades including course work completed through the first semester of your senior year. The transcript must include a cumulative grade point average and rank in class. It may include ACT, SAT, etc. test scores through the first semester of your senior year.
3. Provide two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from an educator. The second letter must be from someone outside of education but not a relative.
4. The Klitz/Linzmeyer Scholarship Committee requests that applicants enclose all information in a sealed 9X12 manila envelope. Letters of recommendation should be enclosed in separate sealed regular business envelopes and included in the 9X12 manila envelope, if possible. Electronic applications are favored and should be delivered through high school counselors.
