## Additional Jobs if you Have More than Four People:

- 5) Real World Relator (Ok, I made that word up) Your job is to find a short article or short video that relates to a theme or topic in your book. You may also choose to research the author of the book. You MUST read the article AHEAD of time and come to class with the article in a GOOGLE DOC or enough copies for people in your group to share. If it is a video, you must have the video link copied into a Google Doc AHEAD of time. You will be sharing your find with your group and explaining the connection in several sentences. If it appears you have not read the article or previewed the video, you will not receive credit. If you are not able to explain the connection to your group in several sentences, you will not receive credit.
- 6) Lexicon Lieutenant- Locate vocabulary in your reading that is unfamiliar to you or that you think might be unfamiliar to your group. You must find two words.
  - Identify the word.
  - Write the sentence from the book with the word in it and indicate page number in parenthesis.
  - Look up the word on Dictionary.com and write the

- definition(s) of the word.
- If multiple definitions exist, choose the definition that fits the context of the book's sentence.
- Together with your group, create a sentence using each new word in proper context. Share with me in a Google Doc!
