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Letter to the Mayor and the BOS

To Whom It May Concern:

According to the City and County of San Francisco's official website:

"City employees aren't allowed to help Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) enforce immigration law except in very limited circumstances or when required by federal or state law."

Yet these words ring hollow today. This promise is being broken — not just quietly, but in full view of the public. The recent abductions of community members show how far we have strayed from the city's sanctuary values. These actions are not isolated; they are symptomatic of a system that is failing to protect the very residents it claims to stand with.

Last year, we stood together in SoMa to stop an ICE raid in its tracks and defend our immigrant neighbors from abduction. All over the bay area folks are fighting to keep ICE out but if our political leaders had the spines we could have this done from the top up!

We vowed it would never happen again, that people would not be taken. Our city's silence only deepens the wound.

The city's own Sanctuary Ordinance clearly prohibits employees from:

- Helping ICE with investigations, detentions, or arrests for civil immigration violations.
- Asking about anyone's immigration status on city forms or applications.
- Restricting city services or benefits based on immigration status.
- Providing personal or release information to ICE.
- Holding people for ICE after they are cleared for release.

Despite these clear laws, the San Francisco Police Department and other city agencies continue to look the other way—or worse, cooperate. Officials claim publicly that SFPD does not assist ICE, but I have seen otherwise.

On July 8, at approximately 10:51 a.m., I witnessed an ICE van incident firsthand.

Contrary to official statements made to Mission Local—that officers arrived at 100 Montgomery only after a van rammed into protesters—I was there, and I saw the truth.

The van sped through the crowd, dragging a person on its hood while officers stood by, motionless. When I pleaded with them to protect the activists, they refused to intervene.

Now, with reports of ICE conducting operations in full coordination at SFO, the city's complicity can no longer be ignored. If San Francisco truly stands for sanctuary, where was that protection when our neighbors and families were ripped from their lives—on our streets and at our own airport?

How can we trust the city's leaders, or the Mayor's Office, when their words of inclusion are not reflected in their actions?

I live and work in San Francisco. I have witnessed these betrayals with my own eyes. Our city must do more than issue statements—it must act, enforce its policies, and hold accountable those who betray them.

I demand answers. I demand justice. And I will not stay silent.
