We are excited to announce the application process for the ES Student Leadership Team! This is for students in grades 2-5. Student Leadership gives students the opportunity to develop leadership skills, experience the democratic process, plan and implement service projects to benefit the school and the community, and encourage and maintain CAC's Core Values through positive behavior within the student body.

Who:

- 1. The Student Leadership Team will consist of two representatives (1 Male & 1 Female) from each 2nd through 5th grade class. These representatives will be elected within their own classrooms by **Thursday**, **September 14th**.
- 2. The students receiving the majority of votes will be the class representative.
- 3. The student representatives will take on the role from September until December. The second elected representatives will start after the winter break.
- 4. The grade representatives will be communicated to students and parents on the Blog by **Sunday**, **September 17th.**
- 5. A student who wishes to be a candidate for the Student Leadership Team should:
- Be a good citizen follow all school rules.
- Be willing to collaborate with other students and adults.
- Be excited about helping our school and community.
- Be able to attend the meetings and involved in activities.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the Core Values through responsible behavior.

Student Leadership meetings will take place every Monday during lunch time 12:10-12:50 pm in the Multi-Purpose room # 42 on the ground floor. The first meeting will be **Monday, September 18th**

How:

- -Interested students will present a 1-2 minute speech to the homeroom class about what makes them a good candidate.
