RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

The school climate at Newington High School is characterized by respect for the rights and dignity of others. Students are expected and required to behave in a socially appropriate manner while on school grounds or at school activities. This means students are expected to comply with school rules and regulations, to be courteous to each other and employees of the school district and volunteer chaperones and to follow the directives of agents of the Board of Education, including administrators, school faculty, secretaries, custodians and cafeteria employees. In the event of illness or injury, the guest's parent/guardian will be contacted.

1. Guests must be at least a freshman in high school.
2. **Guests must be pre-approved by the administration. This form must be completed and signed by an administrator before purchasing tickets.**
3. Only students on the guest list may attend.
4. Students on suspension or expulsion will not be allowed to purchase tickets or attend the event. If this is a prom, students may not have outstanding obligations.
5. The administration reserves the right to prohibit any student from attending school activities.
6. This event is a school function and all school rules apply. Smoking and the use of tobacco are prohibited. Appropriate dress and behavior are expected. See Student Handbook for rules.
7. If the event is a prom, students who are attending must be in school through period 4 on the day of the prom. Students who are absent, cut class or study, arrive late to school or leave without permission will be removed from the guest list and will forfeit the cost of their ticket.
8. Doors open at 7:00pm Students will not be admitted after 7:30 p.m. Parents will be called for any student who does not show up. The event ends at 10 pm. Students must leave the event immediately at its conclusion.
9. Once students enter the facility, they must stay. Students who leave the building will NOT be allowed to re-enter.
10. The use and/or possession of alcohol or drugs will result in suspension and referral to police.
11. Students under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be admitted. Parents will be notified, school suspension will be given, and referral to the police will occur.
12. Any damage to the facilities will be paid by the individuals who are responsible. Referrals will also be made to parents, police, and school administrators for disciplinary action.
13. NHS students attending the event are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their guests.
14. Dancing must be appropriate at all times. Students dancing inappropriately (suggestive, vulgar, or offensive dancing and actions) will be asked to leave.
