

Resolutions Process

Definition

Day Students may participate in the resolutions process at Augsburg University.

A **resolution** is a formal request by a student or student organization that an action or stance be taken by officials at the University. Day Students may petition the Day Student Government to consider resolutions on issues that they care about or that are impacting the student body.

Qualifications for Submitting a Resolution

A resolution may be submitted the <u>Petition for a Student Body Referendum Form on Auggie Life</u> by a student who has paid the Day Student Activity Fee to the Day Student Government; no signatures from other students are required. The resolution may be complete or still in draft form, and representatives from Day Student Government can assist in making changes to a resolution, if needed.

Review Process

These resolutions will be considered and voted on by the Day Student Government on behalf of the entire Day Student Body. The language of one's resolution may be amended or changed by Day Student Government. If approved, representatives from Day Student Government will present the resolution to the appropriate campus officials.
