Class Topic: Upscaling a coffee can into a large revolving organizer

No Pattern to Buy

Required: Bring a working featherweight machine, a new sharp microtext size 12 & 14 machine needle, binding clips, basic sewing supplies: scissors, snips, rotary cutter, mat, ruler, thread, seam ripper, pen or marking pen/pencil/chalk, pins, ¼ inch foot or ¼ inch sewing, edger foot optional, a travel iron and pad (wool mat is recommended). Remember your glasses if you need them.

Recommended: Cut and label your pieces.

Materials and cutting instructions:

1 - #10 coffee can 6.25" in diameter – 7" high and 20.5" around (a 3lb coffee can from Costco) URM has gallon size veggies and pumpkin in a can that is a ½" shorter that we can make work.

E6000 glue.

1 – 5" Lazy Susan They can be bought in bulk on Amazon if you are thinking upcoming gifts or the Quilting Bee can special order one for you by contacting Grace.

- Exterior Main Fabric: Cut 1 – 7.5" x 21". (.5 = ½")
- Exterior Fabric Pockets: Cut 1 - 10" x 34.5".
- Interior Fabric: Cut 1 – 7.5" x 21" . Cut 2 – 6" circles.
- Interior Fabric Pockets: Cut 1 – 10" x 20.5" These pockets are optional.
- Stabilizer: fusible fleece: Cut 1 - 7.5" x 20.5" for lining the wrong side of the Main Exterior Fabric. Cut 2 – 6" circles.

- Light to Medium weight fusible interfacing 5" x 34.5" to use on half of the exterior pockets. This can be pieced together if you have scrapes to use up.
- Binding: Cut- 2 strips 3" x 20.5"
- Bring extra fabric for... just in case!
