

## STATEMENT FROM 2022: (In the process of being revised and updated)

Updated May 2022

We are a group of Bi-Co students who are inspired by mutual aid efforts taking place all over the country. We recognize the disparity of wealth created by capitalism and white supremacy and see how our schools' attempts to promote narratives of total equality on campus erase the needs within our community. We see the unmet needs of many students and want to take matters into our own hands by harnessing redistribution of resources within our community.

What is mutual aid? As Mariame Kaba and Alexandra Ocasio-Cortez put it in their Mutual Aid Tool Kit, "mutual aid means that we understand our survival depends on cooperation, not competition." In doing this work, we wish to honor mutual aid's history in Black and Indigenous Radical Tradition. We understand that mutual aid has always existed in societies that predate settler colonialism and acknowledge that this group's aims of collective care today owe everything to examples set by LGBTQ+ and BIPOC communities, organizers and abolitionists in centuries preceding this one. We acknowledge that mutual aid is *not* reparations, nor is it charity! This is about a sense of collective care and responsibility for our fellow students.<sup>2</sup>

Mutual aid aims to act outside of the bureaucratic systems that often require people to defend any requests for support. Instead, we encourage people to simply ask for what they need. We have no expectation or requirement of any further explanation. At the same time, we hope you can extend the same sense of community trust to us! Our bandwidth is limited by the fact that BCMA is made up of a team of students who care deeply about this work in addition to other commitments. Though our team is made up of Bi-Co students, this project has no official affiliation with either Haverford or Bryn Mawr.

This group was created in late August 2020 as an effort to redistribute wealth with racial justice (particularly as catalyzed by the Covid-19 Pandemic and media attention to anti-Black violence) in mind, and this remains an important consideration on campus given the deep roots of white supremacy that exist in the Bi-Co. **BCMA will consistently attempt to prioritize Black students, students of color, and first generation/low income folks**. Our platform expanded during the Haverford and Bryn Mawr strikes organized by BIPOC students in October and November 2020, and will continue to work as we can to support the racial justice efforts of BIPOC students.

Finally, we want to acknowledge that many services and forms of aid we attempt to provide to students in the community are resources that Haverford and Bryn Mawr should already be providing and are failing to support their students with. Keeping this in mind, BCMA can exist not only to fill these requests, but also to aid and support in forms of advocacy and pressure on our college administrations to better provide for their students. We recognize that while mutual aid is a crucial step in filling the basic needs of students in the short term, this work must happen simultaneously with broader, systemic, anti-capitalist, anti-racist, anti-colonial change.

#### How does it work?

- 1. BCMA solicits contributions from the Bi-Co Community, ONLY when needed.
- 2. The funds pool in a Bi-Co Mutual venmo balance. From there, we can send up to \$5K per week, and/or transfer money into the attached bank account for writing checks.
- 3. Community members request aid through the "Aid Request Form."
- 4. BCMA team reviews the form, contacts students if need be, and makes plans for filling requests.
- 5. BCMA also sends money to groups in Philly for distribution as funds allow.<sup>3</sup>
- 6. At any time, a community member may request a non-monetary service (car ride, grocery pickup, etc), and BCMA will reach out to a network of volunteers to coordinate fulfillment of the request.

### **Aspirations**

**Bi-Co Mutual Aid is not just a bank account.** Although we understand the importance of financial needs, we also aim to create a more fundamental network of collective care and non-monetary aid. We have resources available to provide car rides, grocery deliveries, prescription pickups, job connections, gender-affirming clothing and more. In addition, we are willing to work with any student who reaches out to us with a need or request not currently in our form.






### **ARCHIVE OF PAST MEMBERS**
