

HOW WE USE COOKIES

Amiokaa Cookie Policy

Amiokaa is committed to protecting your privacy. This policy explains how and why we use cookies on our website, what types of cookies we use, and how you can manage your preferences. It should be read alongside our [Privacy Policy] and [Terms and Conditions].

We aim to be transparent about our use of cookies and are committed to complying with relevant UK and EU legislation, including the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) and the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR).

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, phone or other device when you visit a website. They store information about your visit and can be used to support the functioning of the website, improve your user experience, or remember your preferences.

Cookies are either:

- Session cookies – these are temporary and deleted when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies – these remain on your device until they expire or are manually deleted.

Cookies can also be:

- First-party – set by the website you are visiting.
- Third-party – set by a different domain (not currently used on our site).

What cookies does Amiokaa use?

As of the date of this policy, Amiokaa only uses strictly necessary cookies and accessibility preference cookies. We do not use any tracking, advertising, analytics, or social media cookies.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

The cookies we use include:

1. Essential Session Cookies

These cookies are required for the basic operation and security of our website. They enable core features such as secure navigation between pages and form submissions. Without them, our site would not function properly.

2. Accessibility Preference Cookies (UserWay)

We use a free version of the UserWay accessibility plugin. This sets cookies to remember the settings you choose (such as text size, contrast mode, and other adjustments) so you don't have to reconfigure them every time you visit.

These cookies:

- Are limited to storing local preferences
- Do not track your activity across the web
- Do not identify you personally

Cookies we do not use

Amiokaa does not currently use:

- Google Analytics or other analytics/tracking tools
- Social network plugins (e.g. Facebook 'like' or Twitter 'share' buttons)
- Advertising cookies
- Flash cookies or tailored content cookies

Your choices and control

You can manage or delete cookies through your web browser settings at any time. Most browsers allow you to:

- See what cookies are stored

- Enable private browsing or 'incognito' mode
